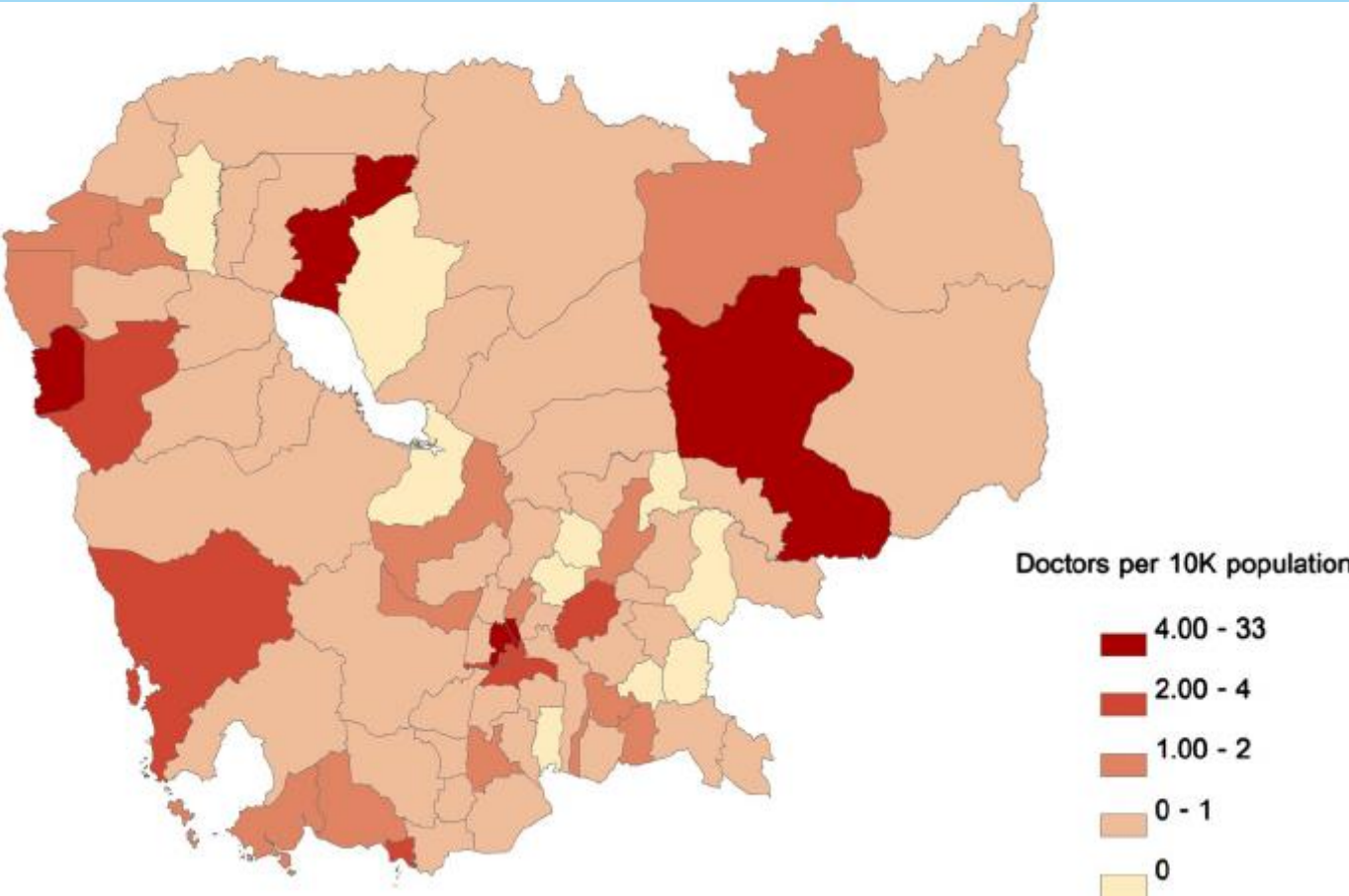
Number of Doctors per 1000 Patients in 2019

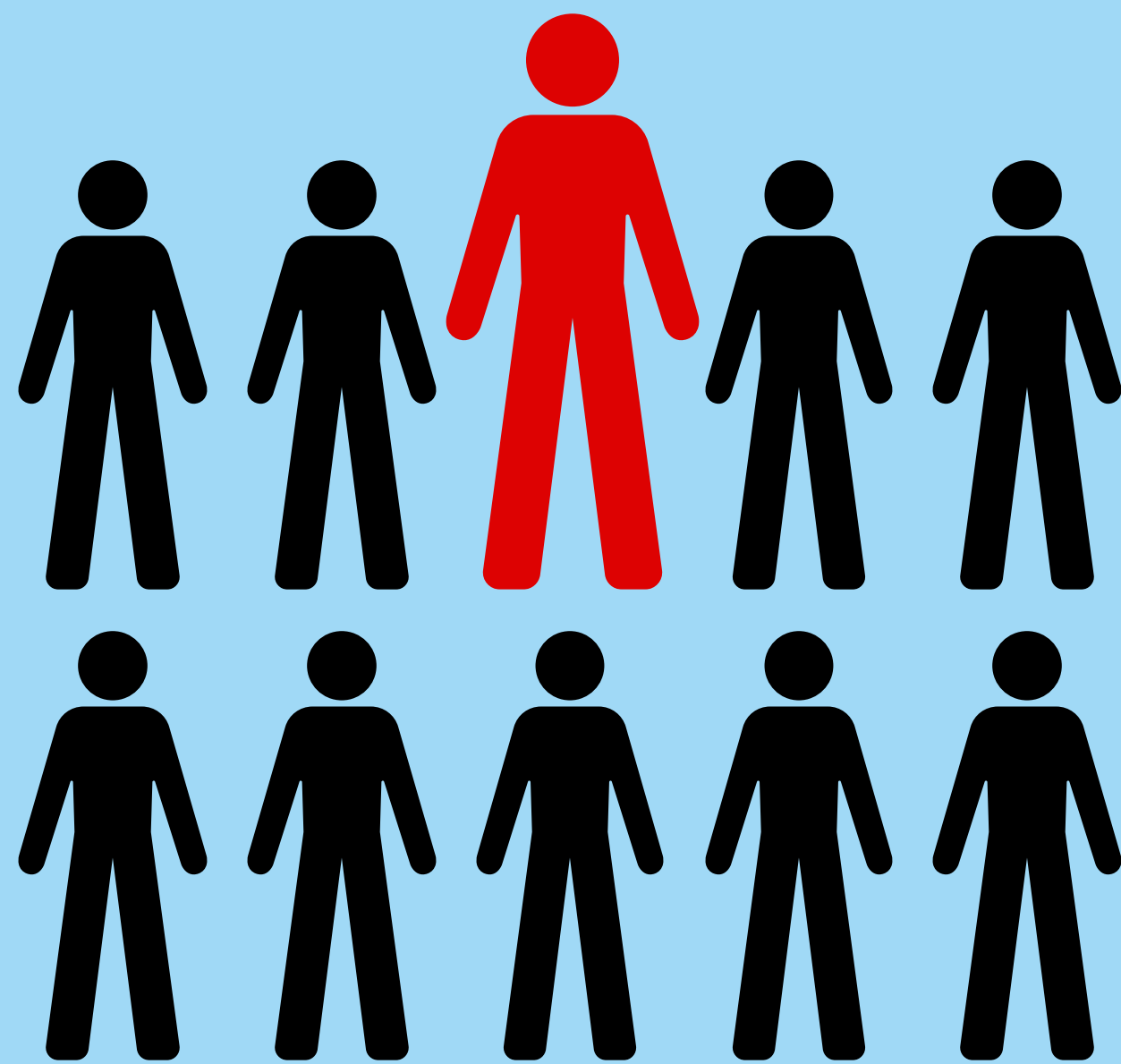

Unequal Distribution of Doctors



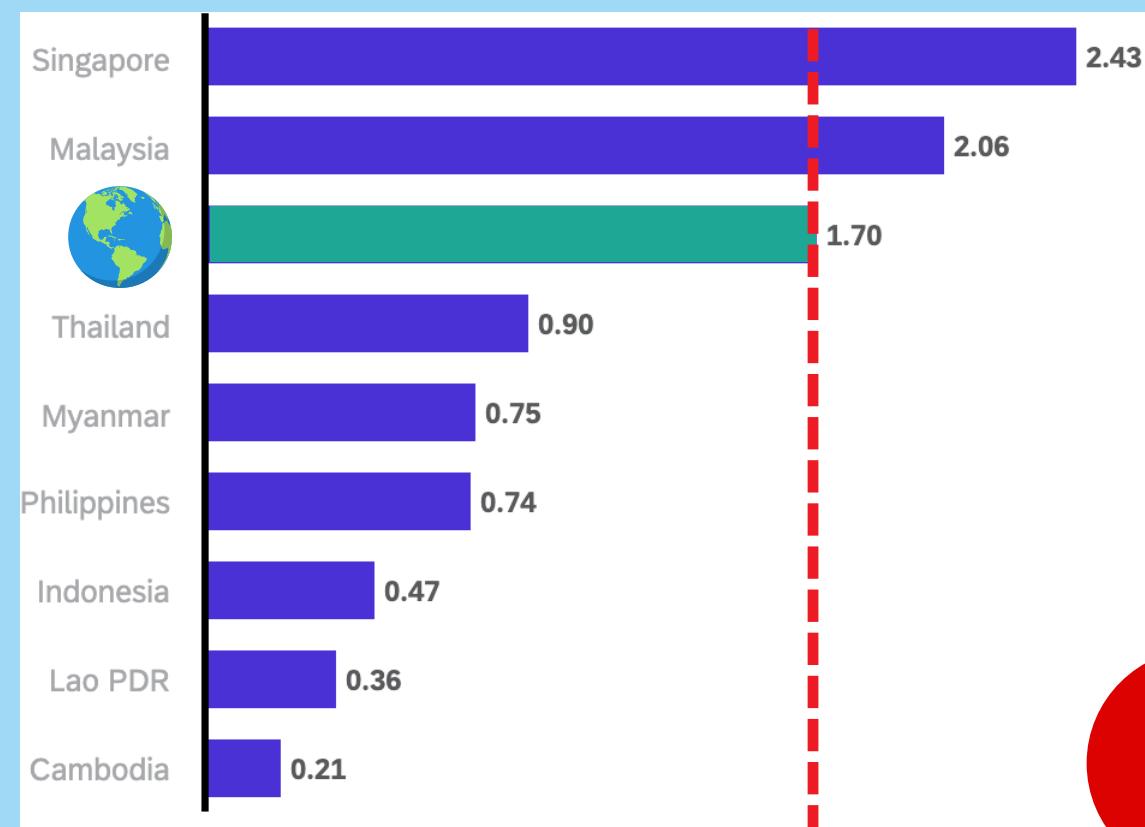

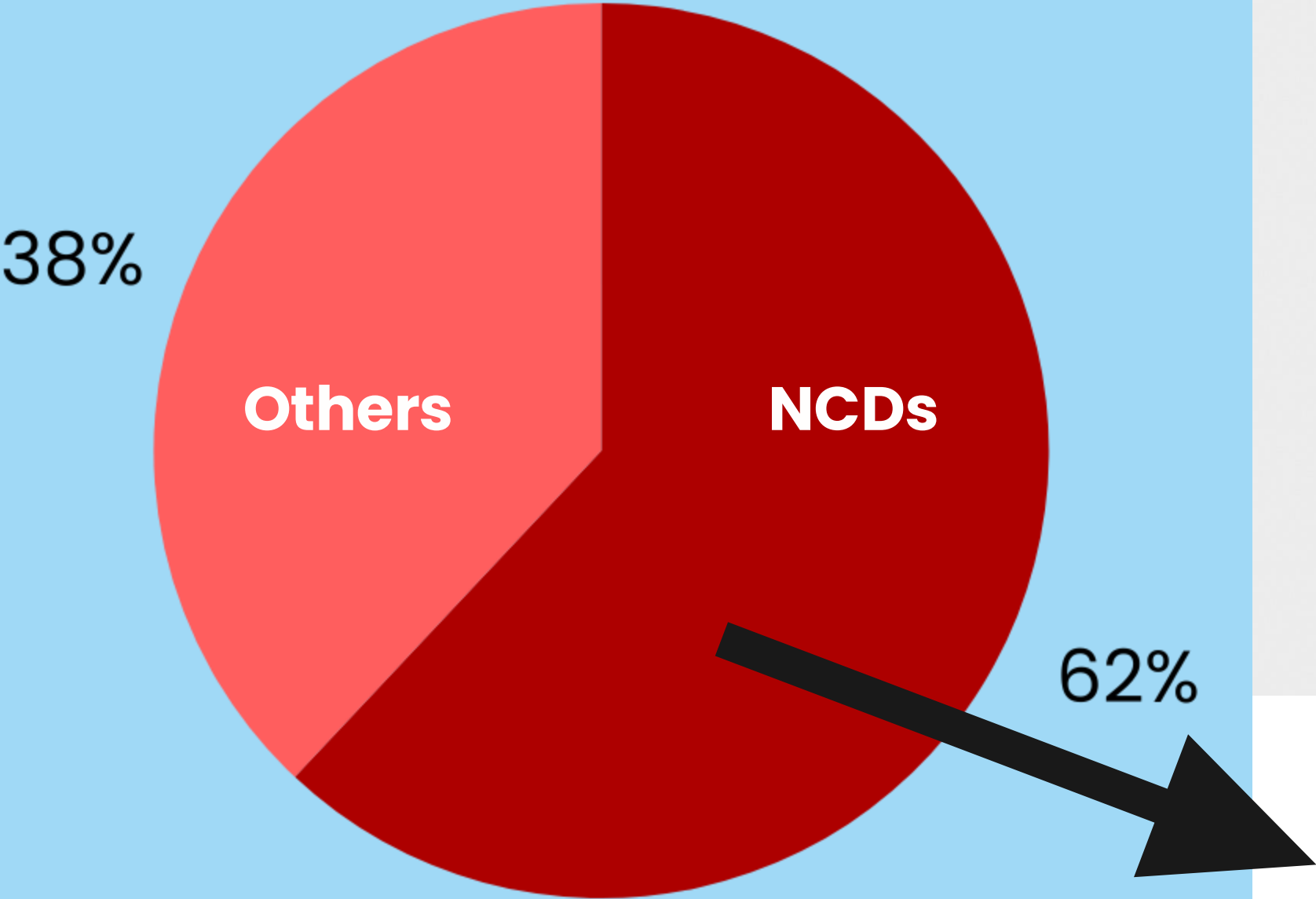




Vulnerable Groups: Chronic Disease Patients



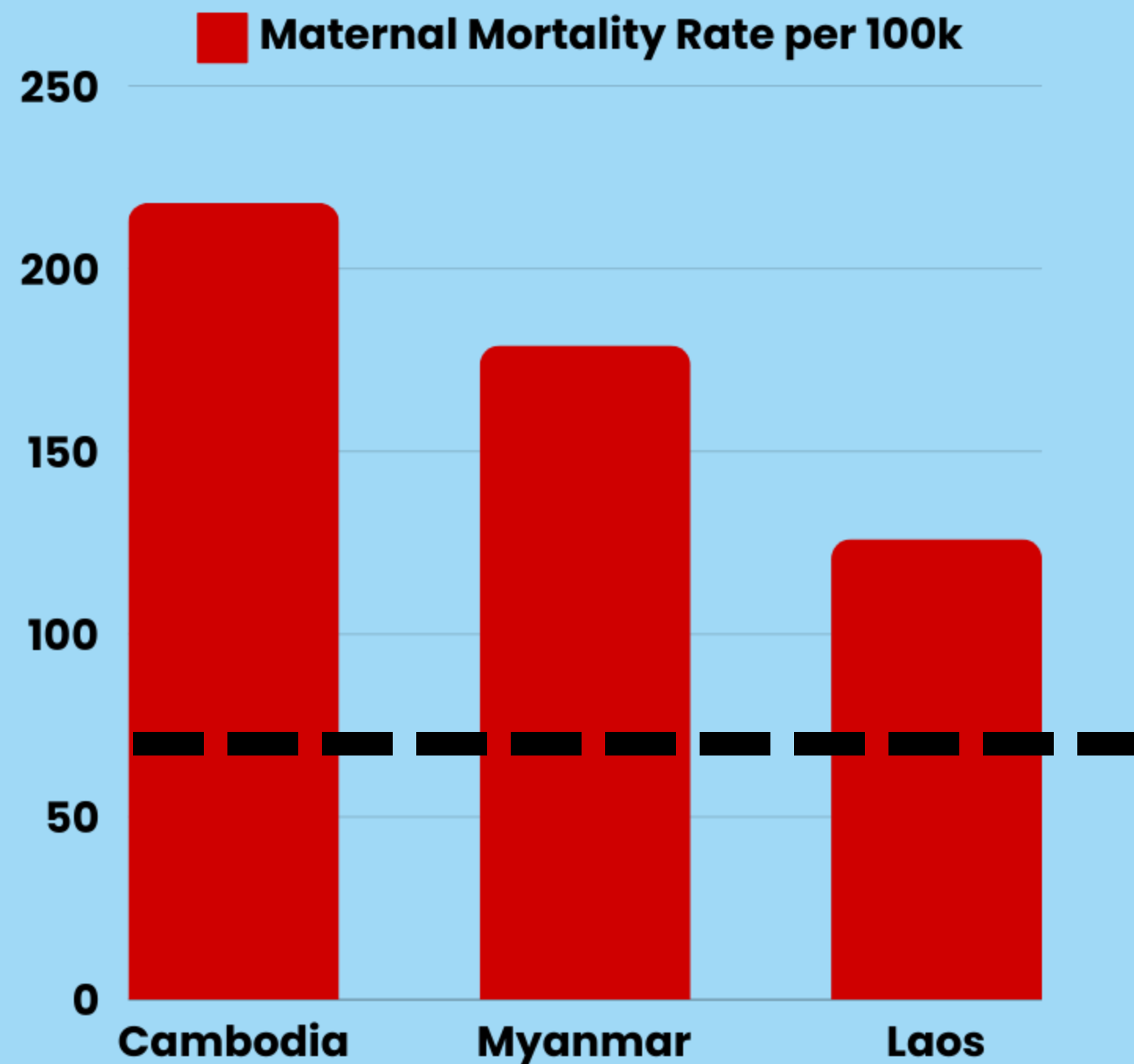
Percentage of Deaths in South-East Asia

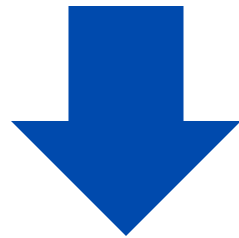
Vulnerable Groups: Pregnant Women

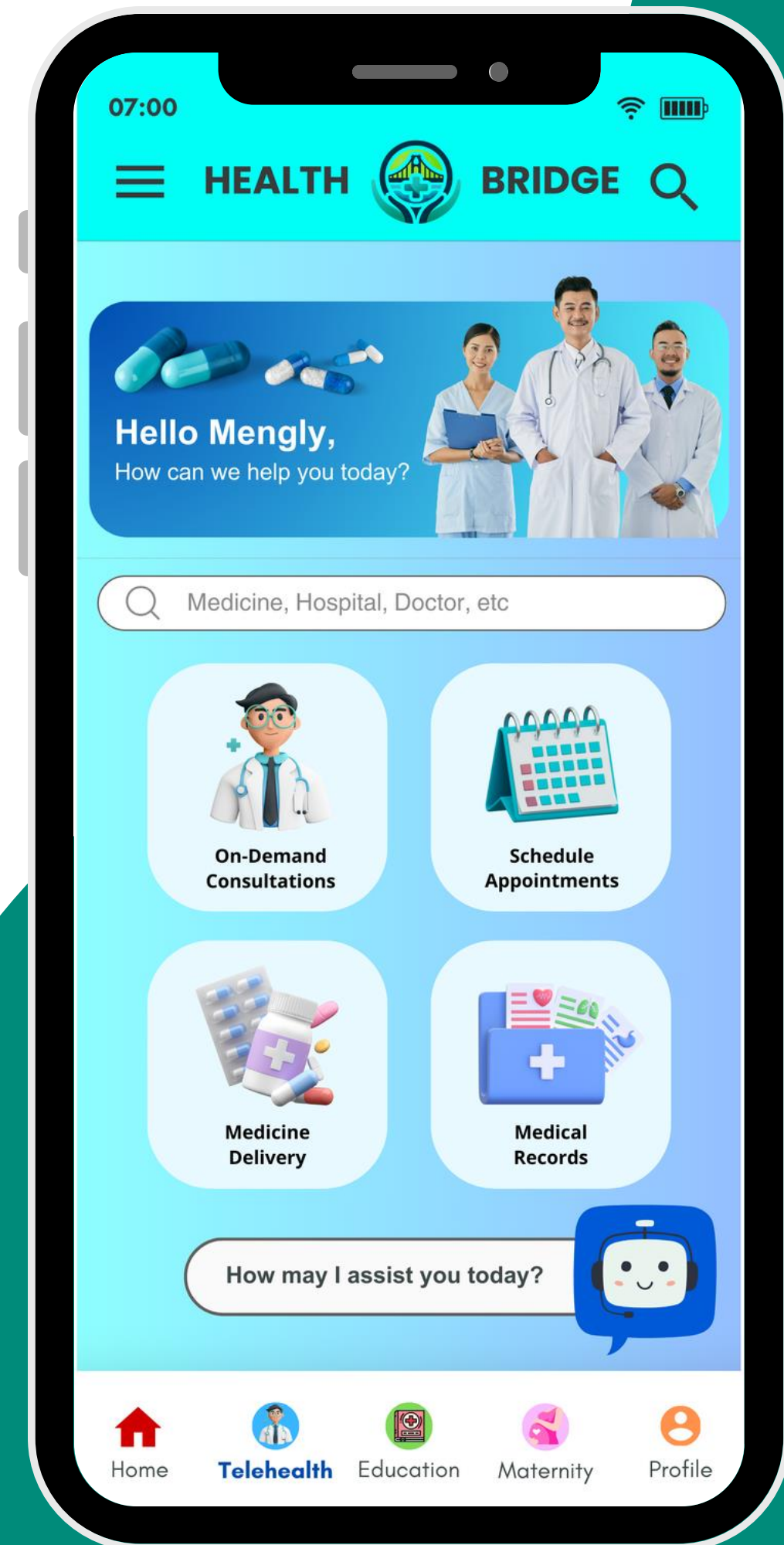


Feature 1: Telehealth Consultations

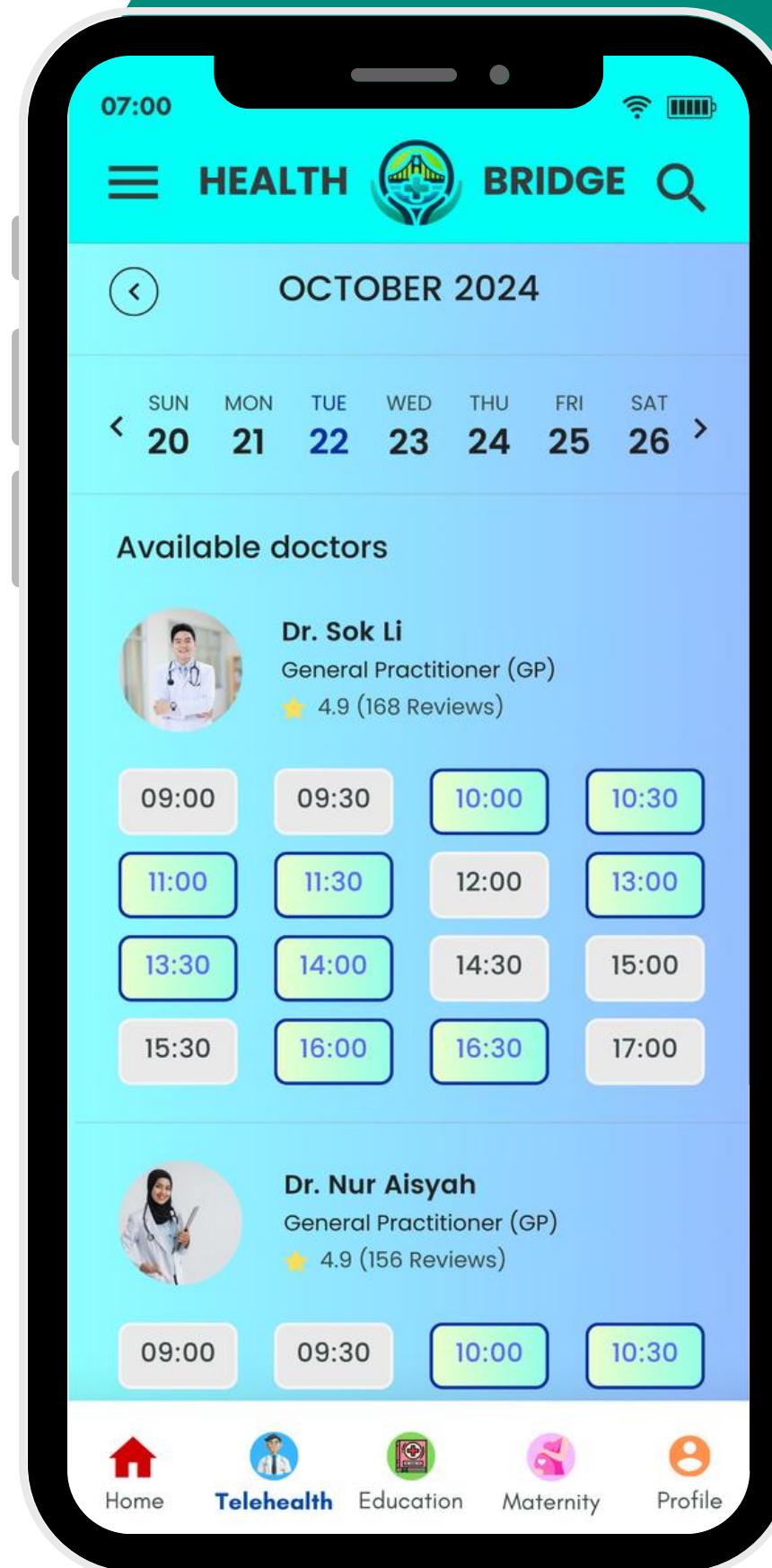


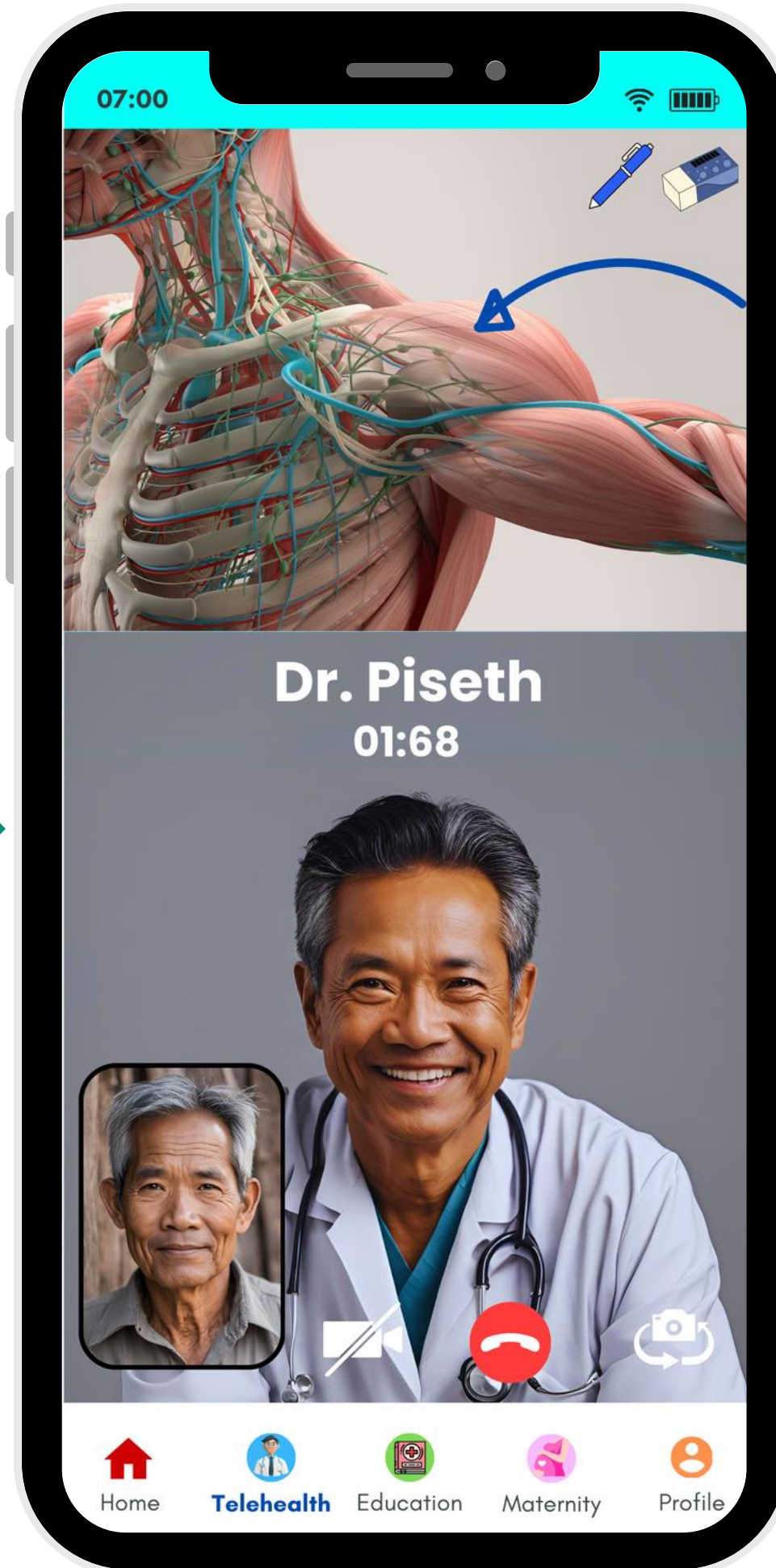
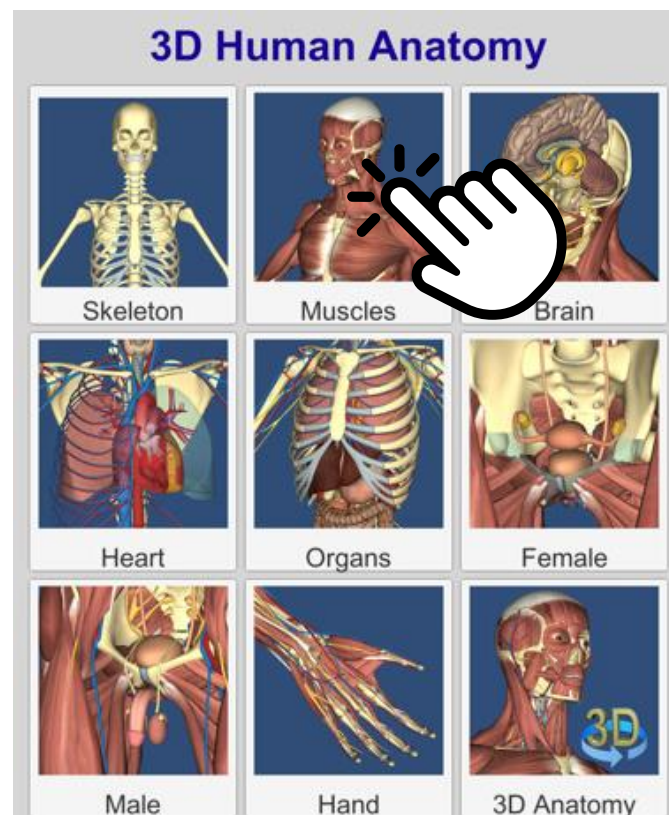


Schedule an Appointment

Consult with Your Doctor



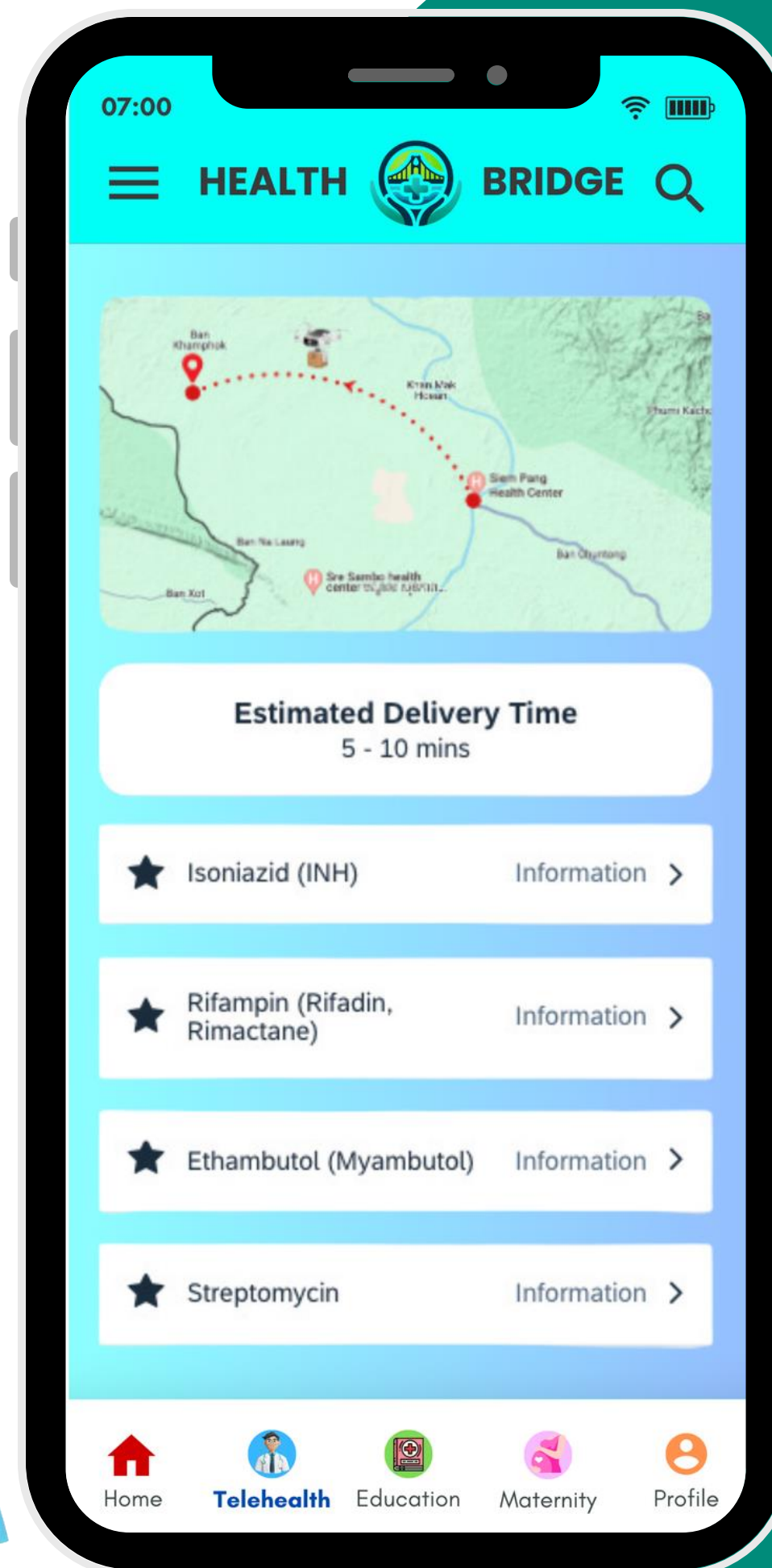
- The doctor and patient can easily interact with **3D anatomical models** to point out areas of pain or discomfort
- Doctors can then **draw and annotate on these models** in real-time, helping to explain conditions clearly and provide more accurate diagnoses



Medicine Delivery



- After your consultation, the doctor sends a **digital prescription** to the app, allowing you to order medication for **home delivery** without needing to visit a pharmacy.



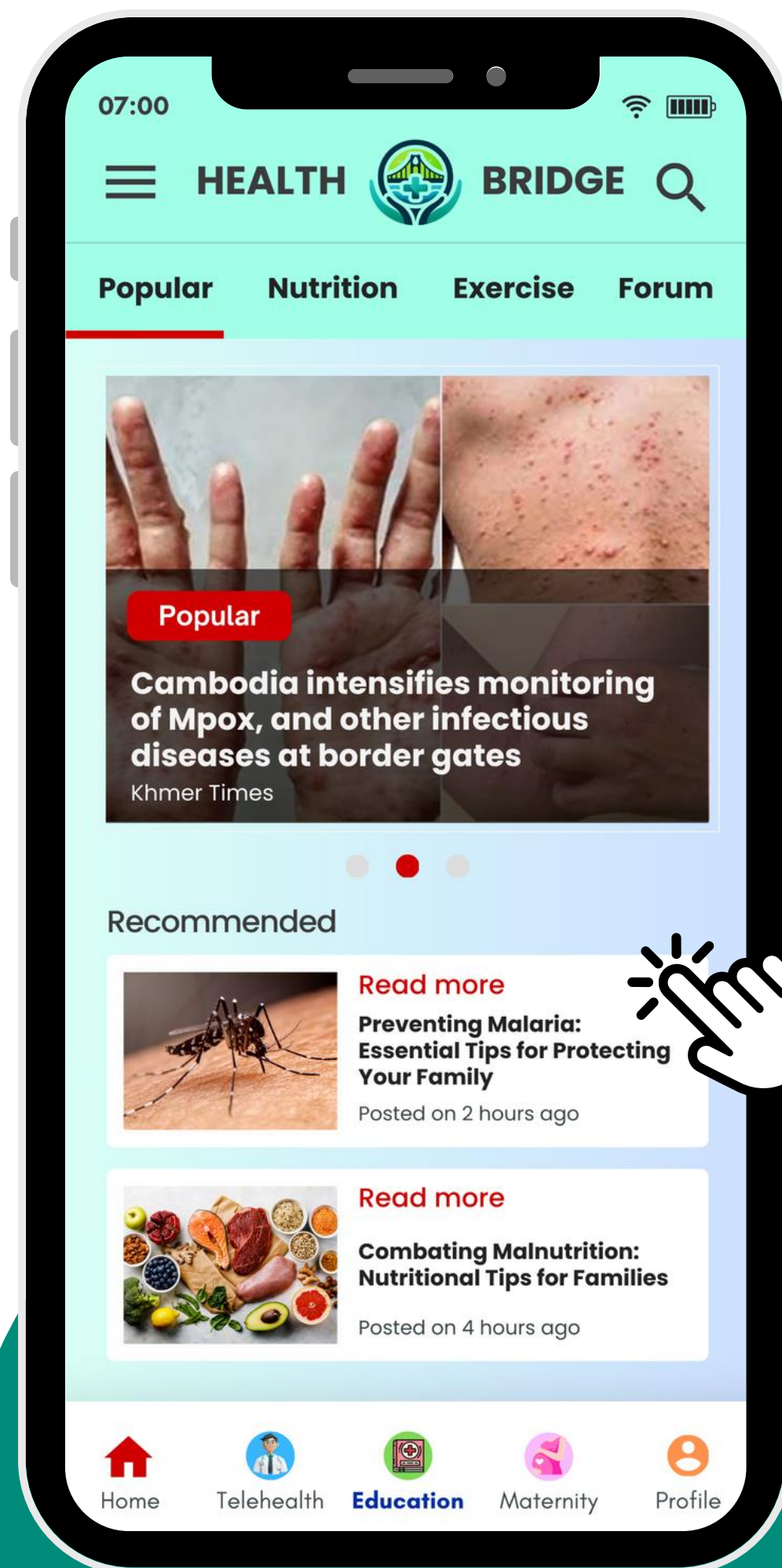


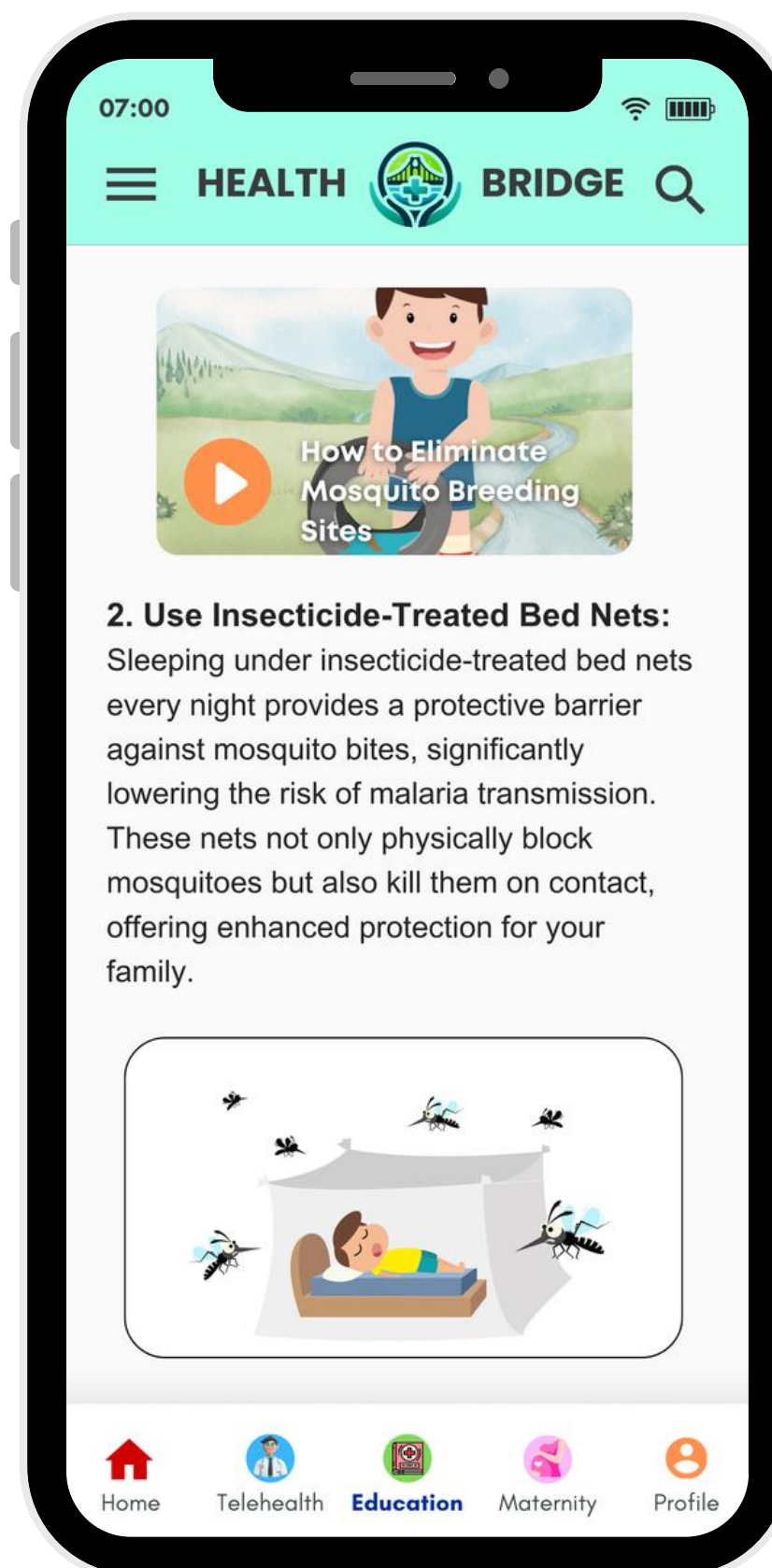

Tailored Health News



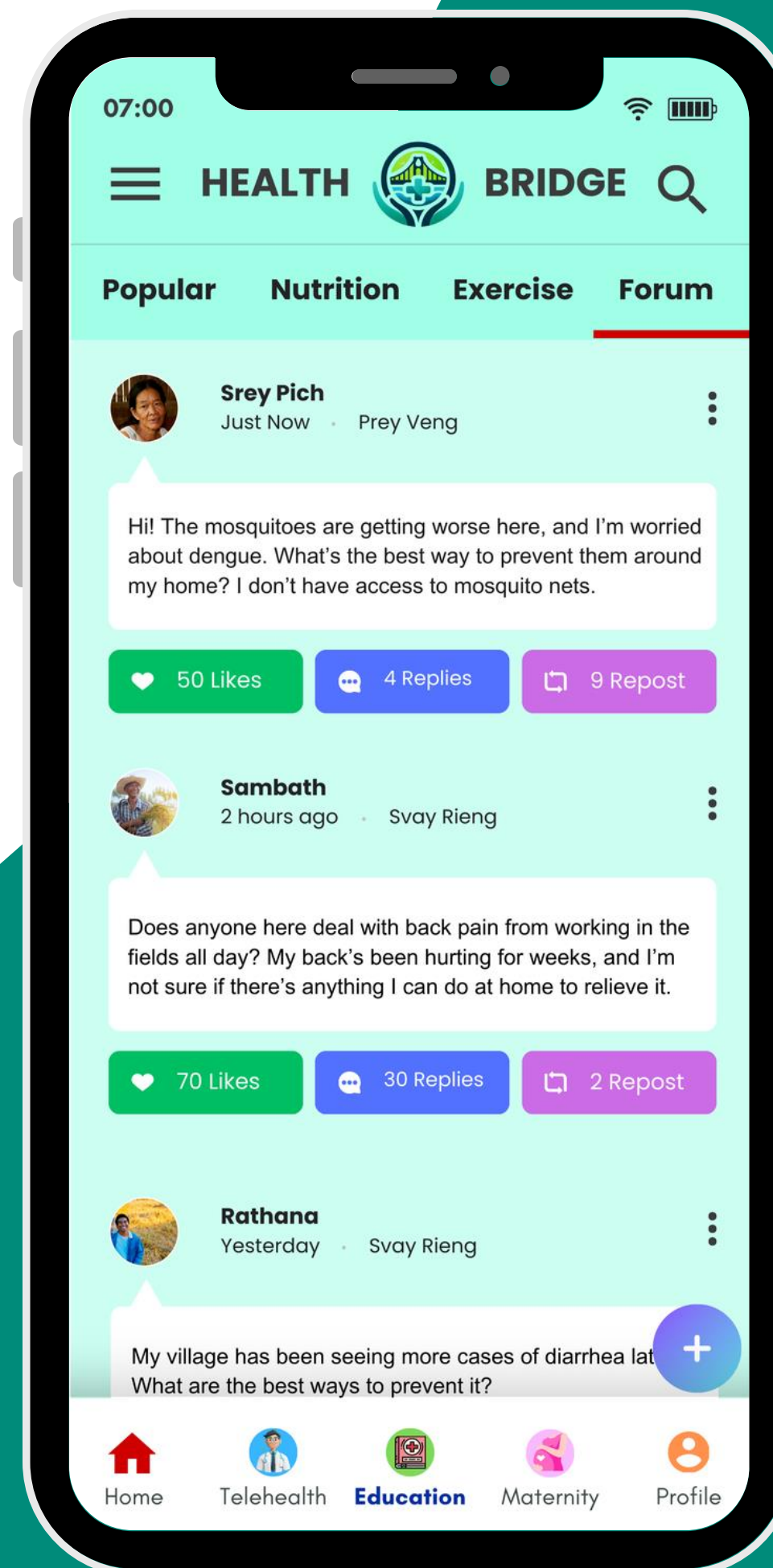
- If malaria is prevalent in the user's area, they will receive **articles on malaria prevention**, including tips like eliminating mosquito breeding sites and using insecticide-treated nets.

- A **community space** for users to engage in **health discussions**, ask questions, and exchange experiences, with **moderation in place** to maintain accuracy and encourage participation on local health concerns.



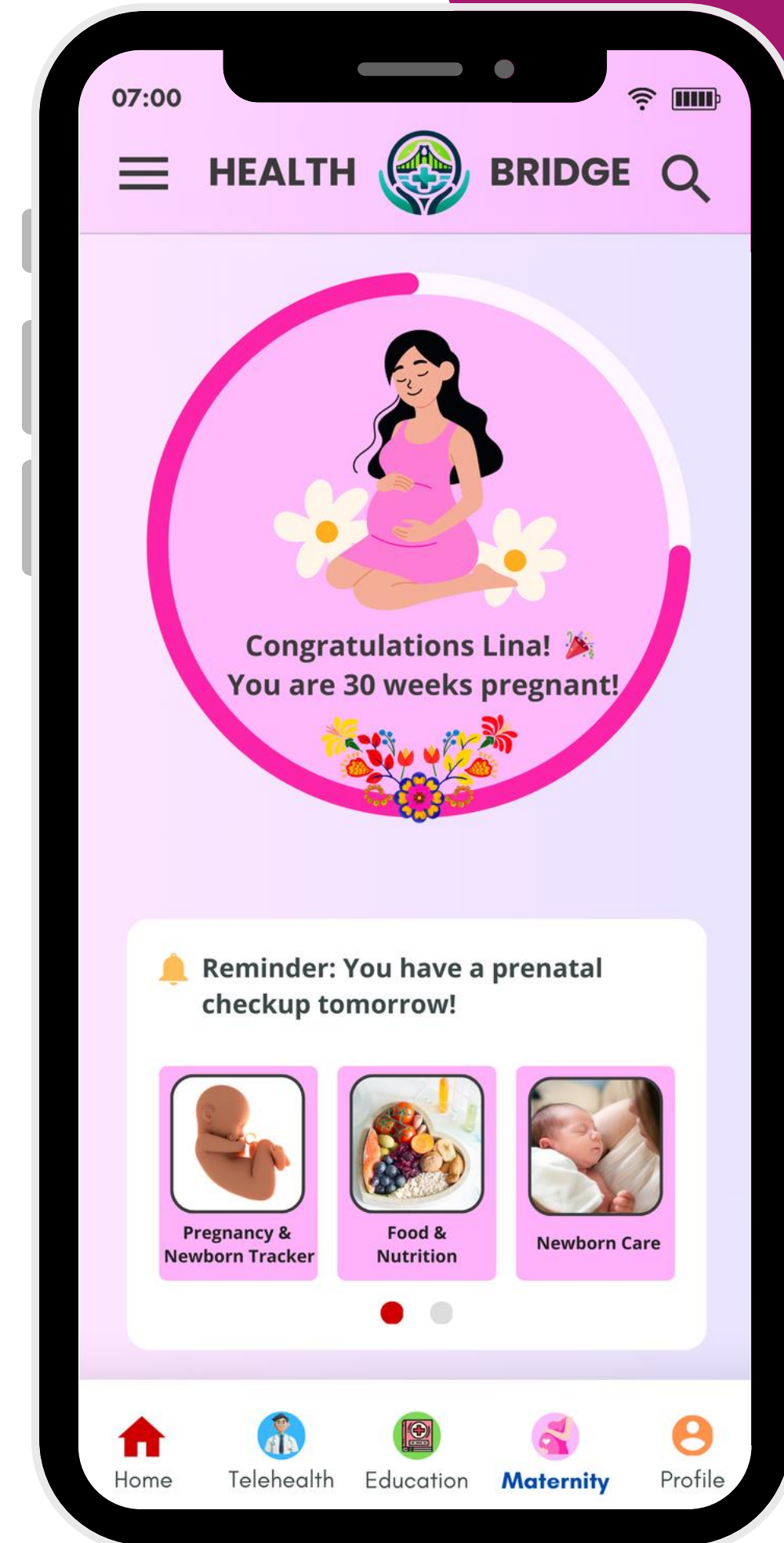

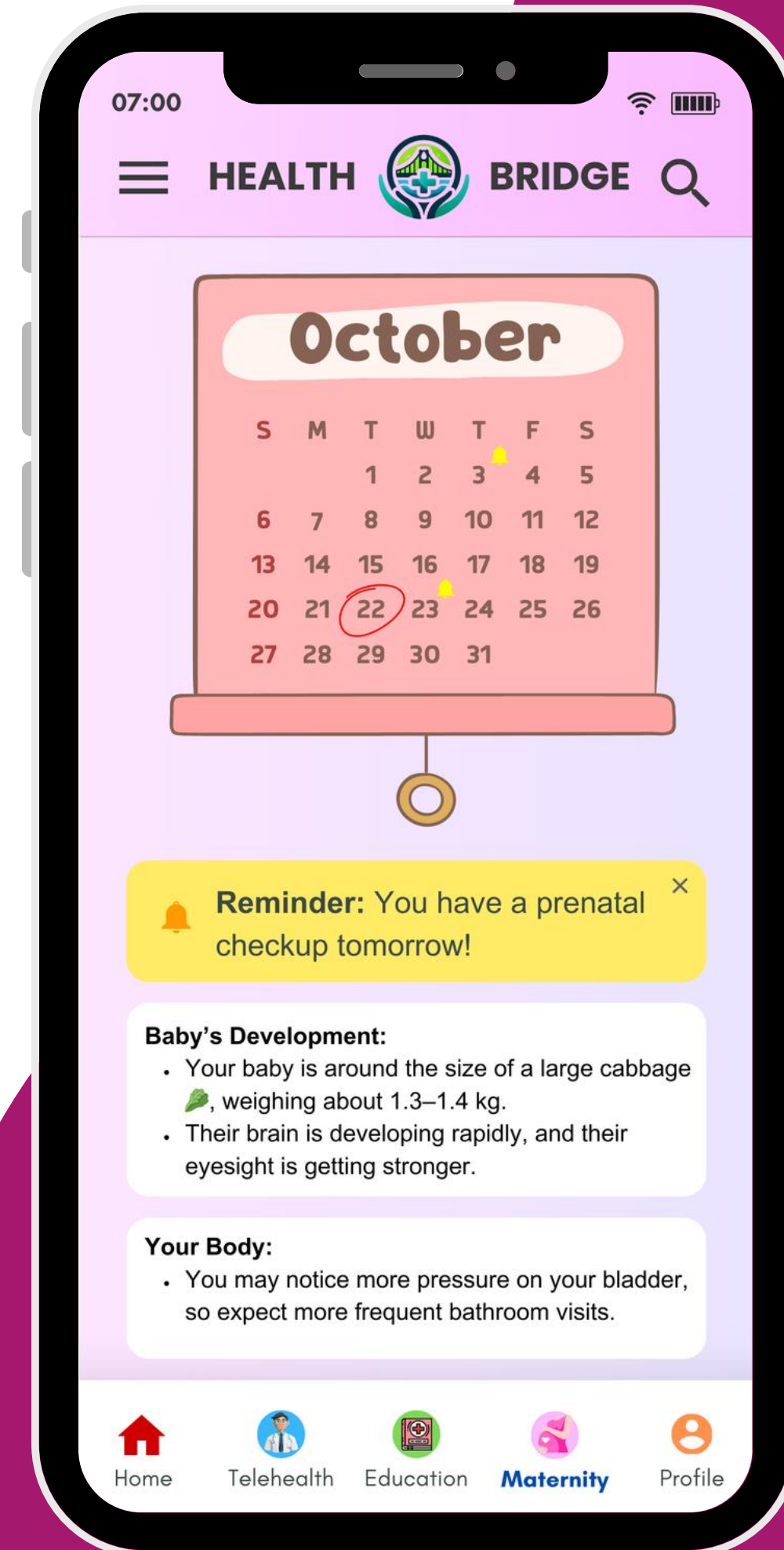

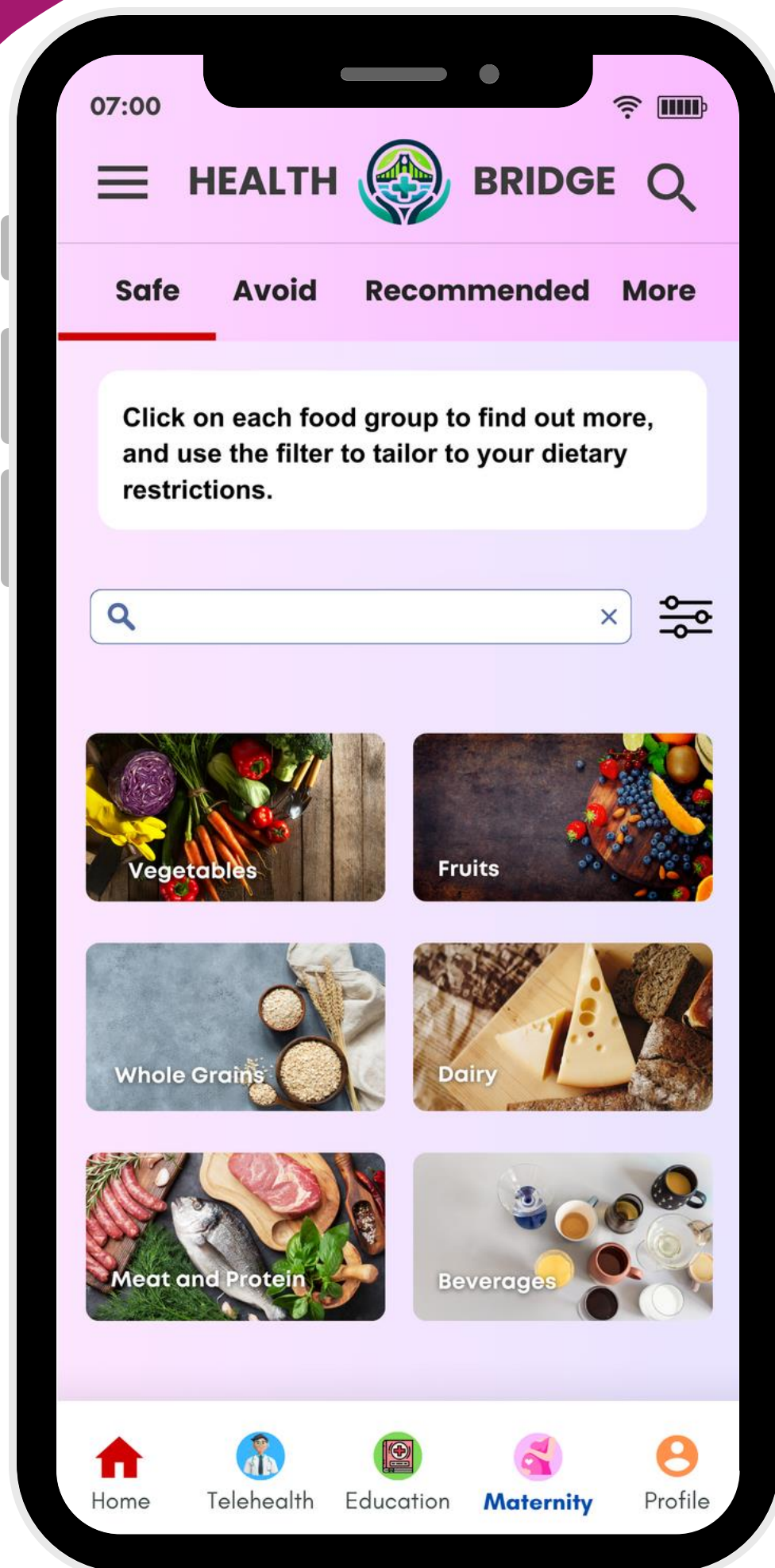




Maternity and Newborn Tracker

Food & Nutrition

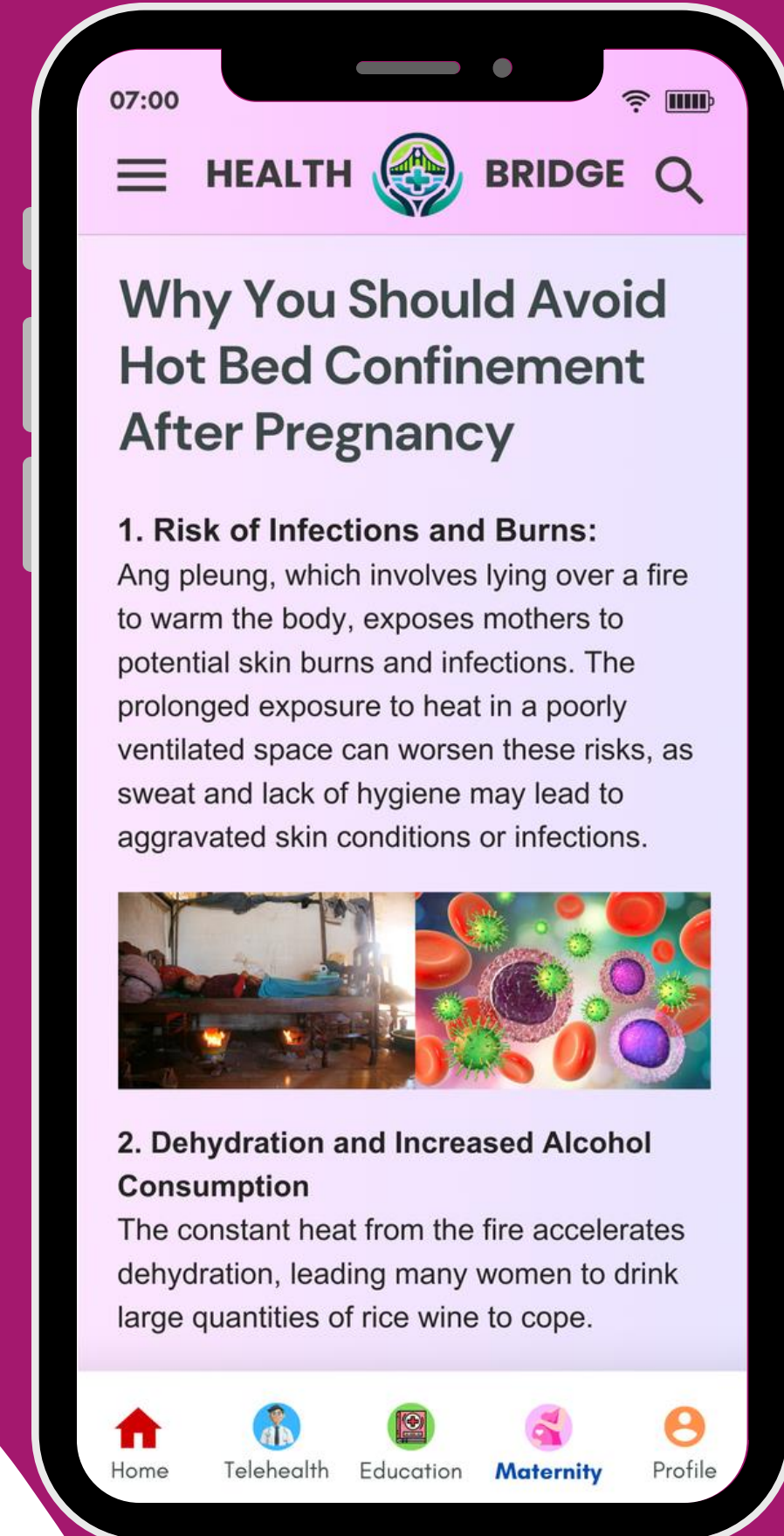
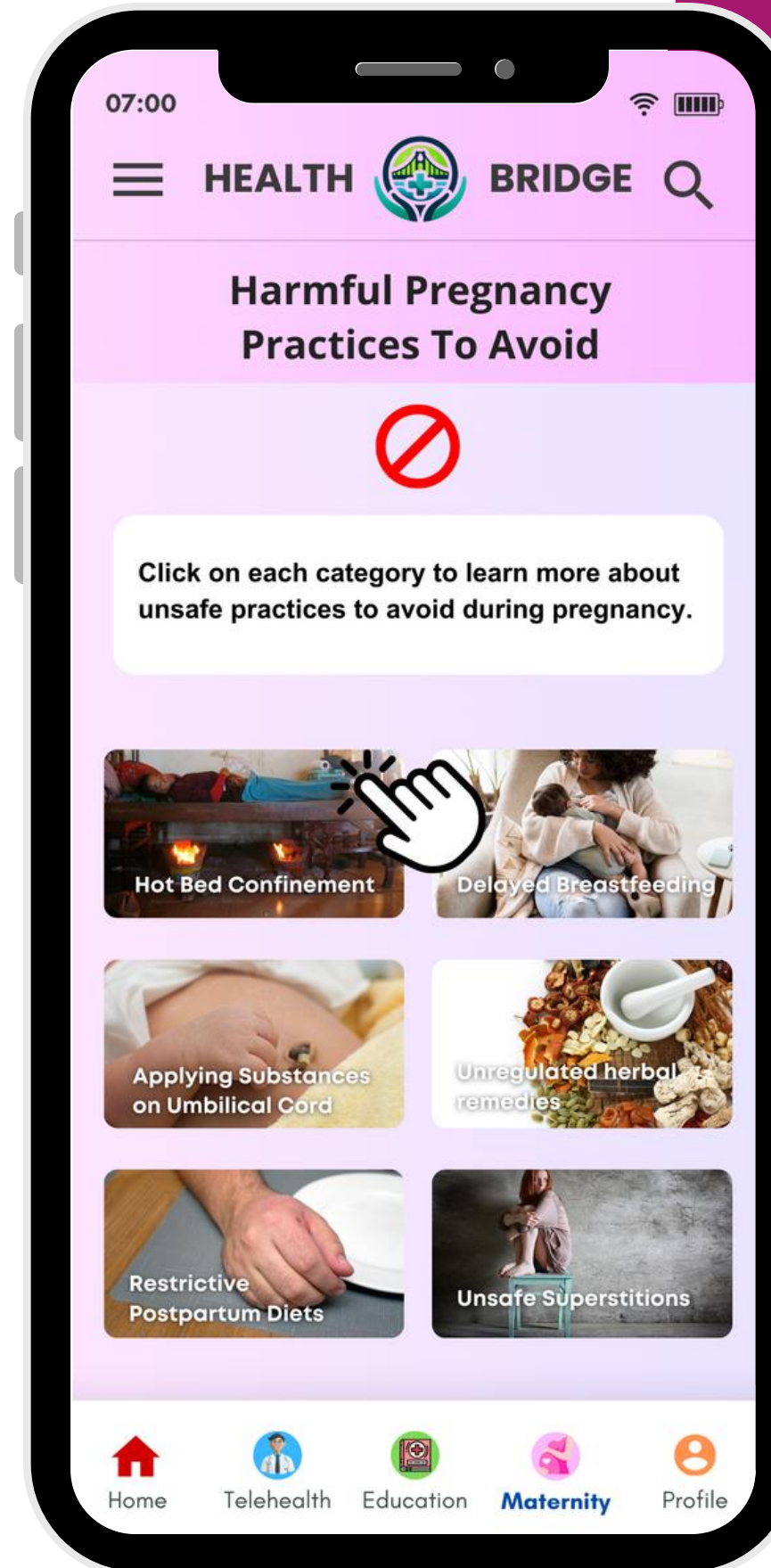
- Offer **detailed advice** on which foods are **beneficial** and which to **avoid** during pregnancy.

Avoid Harmful Practices



- Educate users about **harmful traditional or outdated practices**, such as **hot bed confinement**, applying unsafe substances to the umbilical cord, or delaying breastfeeding.

Appendix 1: Telehealth Market Size & Trends



- The Southeast Asia telehealth market size was valued at USD 8.5 billion in 2022 and is expected to grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 28.9% from 2023 to 2030.
- Increasing penetration of the internet and the constant evolution of smartphones and tablets have made accessing telehealth services more convenient and are expected to contribute to the growing demand.
- Users are increasingly turning aware of the importance of monitoring health and fitness to control the incidence of chronic ailments and are using their smartphones to track the same.

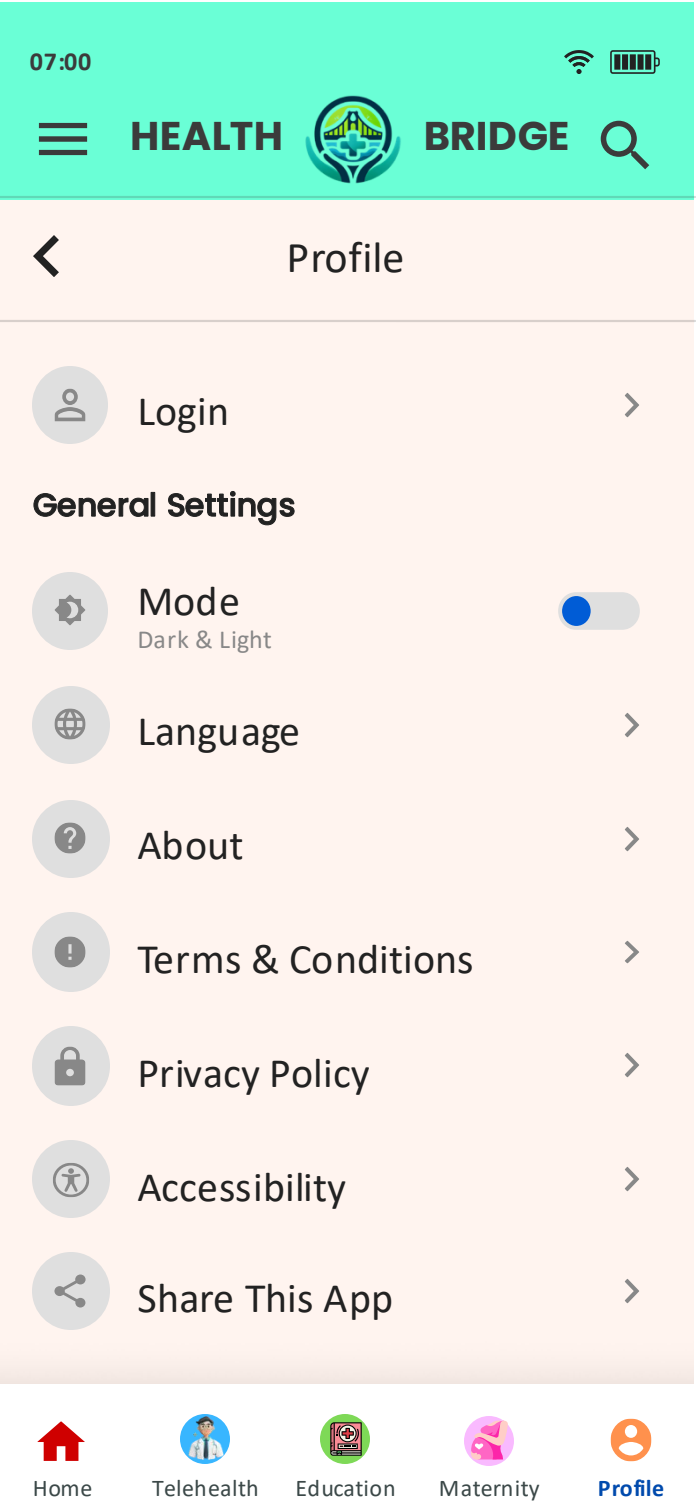

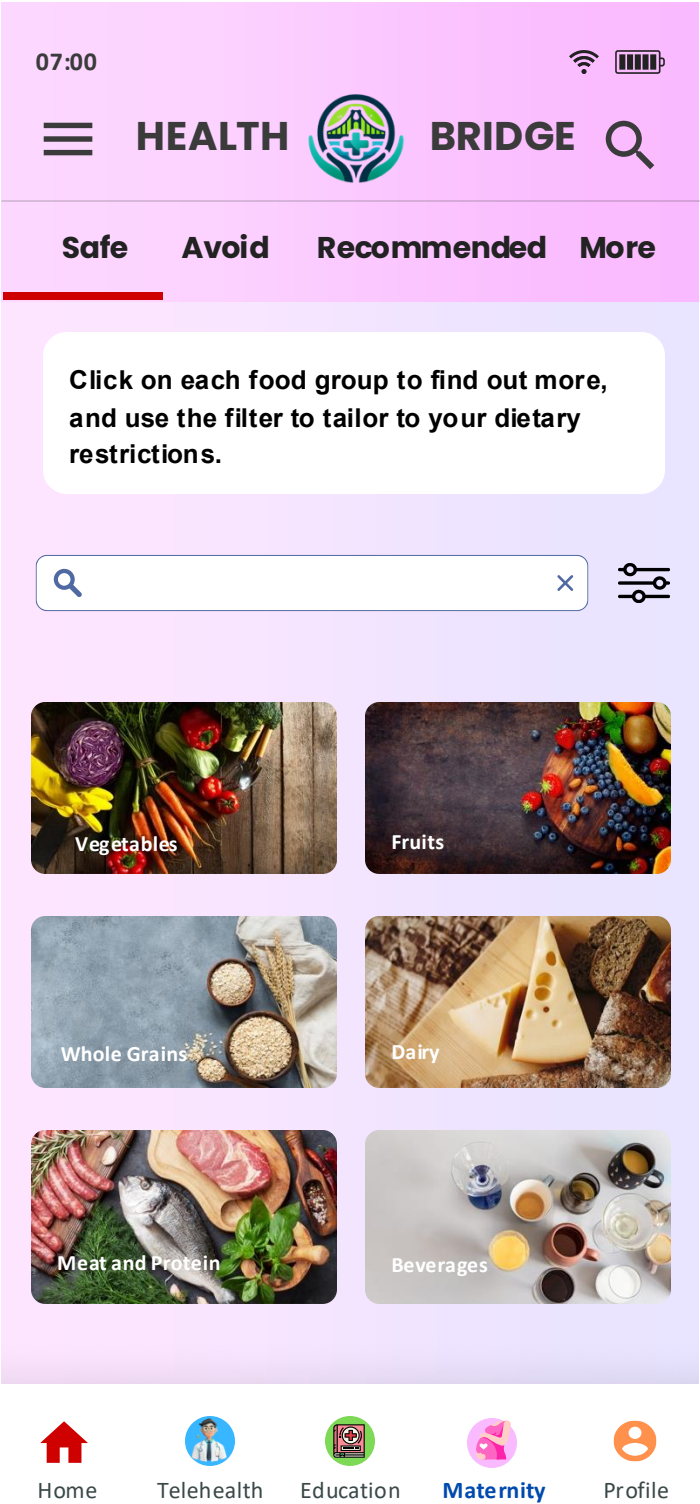

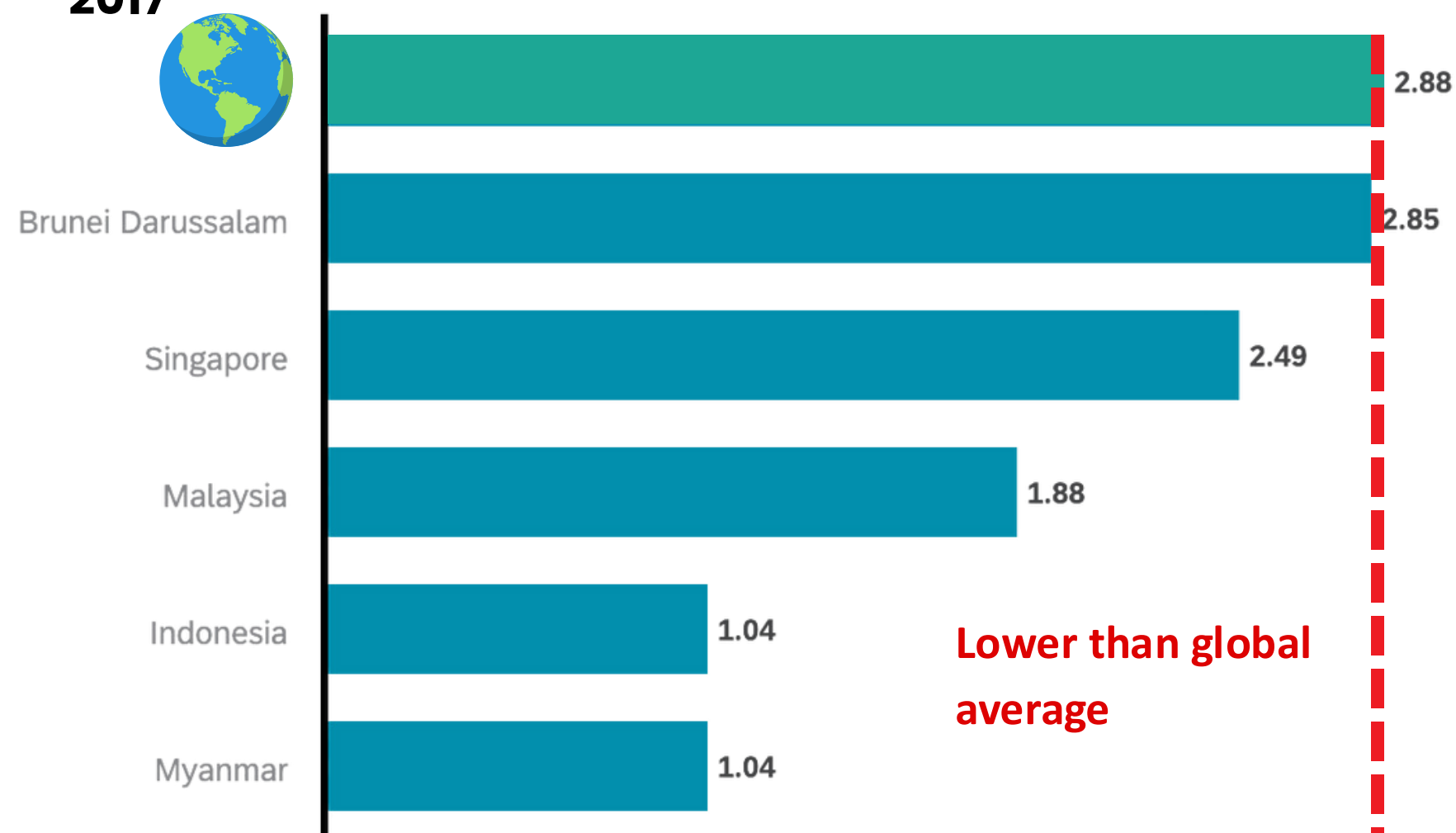

Number of Hospital Beds per 1000 Patients in 2017



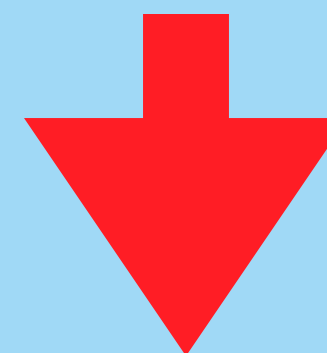

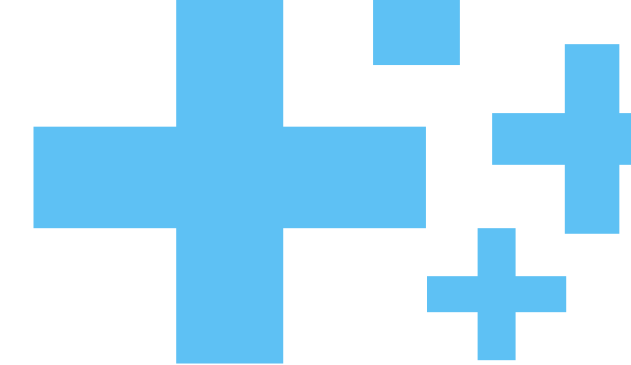
