

%Unemployment rate of ASEAN during 2004-2016




- 2014, 7 out of 10 ASEAN countries have over 11 millions people unemployed.


Malaysia's unemployment rate – increased from 2.87% to 3.3% (2014 – 2016)




Youth Unemployment Rate

%Youth unemployment rate in 2004




%Total unemployment rate of youth (15-24) in ASEAN 2016
